Warren Nelson, Founder and Artistic Director of Lake Superior Big Top Chautauqua, was commissioned to write his 14th historical musical show, “CENTENNIAL GREEN: The Over and Understory of the Forest Service in Song”, to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the U.S. Forest Service. Through a partnership with the Forest Service, Nelson was supplied with historical and visual materials that were woven into this story which pays tribute to the men and women who care for 193 million acres of public forests and grasslands. Big Top Chautauqua debuted the show in Bayfield Wisconsin; and later presented a special performance at Milwaukee's historic Pabst Theatre, which was filmed in high-definition by Milwaukee Public Television.

Lake Superior Big Top Chautauqua is a 900-seat canvas tent theatre which presents original shows on summer nights near Bayfield, Wisconsin and tours their original shows throughout the country. Tent Show Radio, a weekly variety series hosted by Warren Nelson, showcases live performances from the summer stage, and is heard on listener-supported radio stations across the country.

Central to the Big Top Chautauqua mission is the creation, production, and presentation of a growing repertoire of Chautauqua Original Musicals. These shows offer a unique combination of music, drama, poetry, and big-screen visuals that bring to life the faces, places, and events of the past. With original songs by Warren Nelson, visuals by **Betty Ferris**, and the impressive musical talents of the Blue Canvas Orchestra & Singers, the Chautauqua Original Musicals have received numerous awards including one from the Wisconsin Historical Society which hails it as “one of the most original, creative, and distinguished public interpreters of local, state, and regional history in the entire United States.”
